

AWANA REGIONAL GRAND PRIX RULES

1. Cars MUST have been built the same club season as the race entered.
Example - A regional race in Feb. 2004 would include cars built from September 2003 on.
2. Car MUST be built from AWANA GRAND PRIX car kits, including axles, wheels, block of wood, etc,
3. Cars MUST have raced in a LOCAL Grand Prix PRIOR to racing in the Regional.
4. Cars may be worked on after the local race, BUT the intent is to race the same basic car.
5. ALL cars will be checked on a scale and put through a " GO-NO-GO " Box. Size and weight are the same as outlined in the AWANA Grand Prix kits or rule book, CHECK this at your local church PRIOR to Regional registration.
6. Once registered at the Regional, NO work may be done to the car.
7. Cars will be registered in both SPEED & DESIGN competition BUT cars will only receive one trophy for either speed or design.
8. In case of illness on Race Day, a substitute driver will be permitted. Any awards earned will go to the registered owner, not the substitute.
9. DESIGN awards are based on WOOD WORKING ability. Plastic car kit parts may be used, but do not receive as high a score as actual work done by the CLUBBER / TEEN/ADULT.
10. DESIGN awards also include ORIGINALITY! Cars do not have to have an INDY 500 look, but still must pass the size test.
11. All Clubbers and Leaders should be in full/proper AWANA Uniform, Varsity Teens (not in LIT uniform) and other adults should wear conservative Christian clothing.
12. AWARDS will be give to the Top winners in each class: 3 in Design, and 3 in Speed. This applies to 3rd/4th grade, 5th/6th grade, and JV. Separate awards will be give to the top 3 winners in the Adult SPEED & DESIGN competitions. (Awards depend on number of participants for adults.) If there are not enough card to compete in a single division they may be combined with another division.

13. CONDUCT is to be CHRISTIAN in attitude and nature! Unruly behavior can lead to disqualification or expulsion. This applies to ALL participants, including adults.

Scales, weights, go-no-go box, and tracks will be provided by the Awana Missionary.
